

Guidelines

- The abstract must be written in English. Non-native speakers are encouraged to have the texts proofread before submission.
- The body of the abstract must be written in a single paragraph and have a maximum of 250 words.
- The body of the text must not contain figures, photos and tables.
- Carefully fill out the requested information during the on-line submission process. Names, affiliations, e-mails etc. will not be proofread by the SEFS13 Scientific Committee, so make sure the information is correct before submission as it will be quoted as submitted.
- Abstracts may be submitted for an oral or poster presentation. Please note that the scientific committee reserves the right to suggest changes from oral to poster presentation and vice versa.
- Each participant may submit and present no more than three contributions.
- Note that you will be asked to select a first preference session for your abstract. You will also be asked to select other appropriate sessions for your abstract. In the event that a first preference session does not proceed, authors will be assigned to one of their alternative session choices.

Terms and Conditions

- Presenting authors must ensure that they are registered before attending the conference. Any presenting authors who are not registered in time for the conference will have their abstract(s) removed from the program.
- The presenting author is required to ensure that all co-authors are aware of the content of the abstract before submission. By submitting an abstract, the submitting author attests that the abstract submitted has been approved by all co-authors.
- Presenters will be informed of the outcome of their submission via email sent exclusively to the e-mail address of the author responsible for the presentation.
